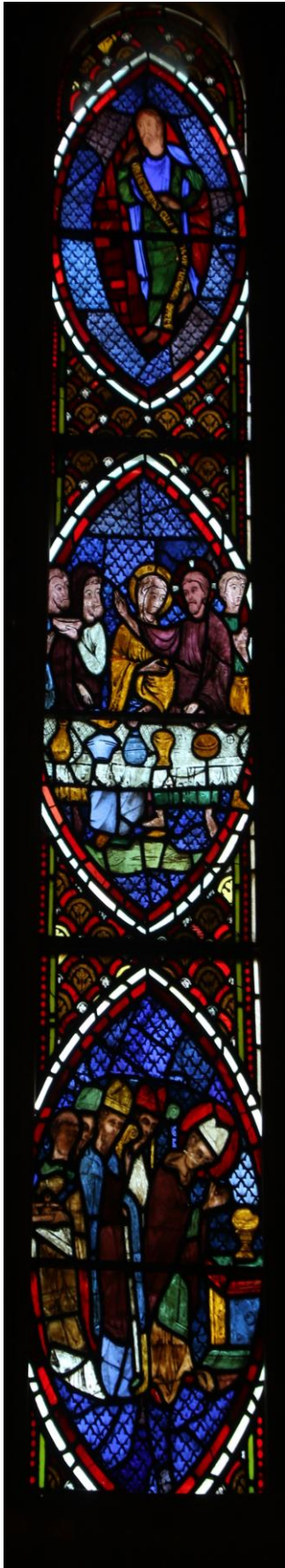

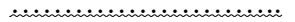

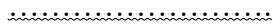

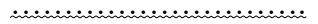

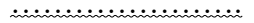

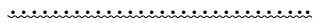


The Ascension

 Christ in glory with his arms outstretched.



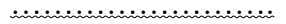
Three Angels carrying ribbons which read.

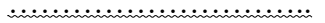
